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SEN Diary

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Overview

This software is intended to be used by all Special Education Needs Co-ordinators (Sencos) working with pupils at all key stages. It is designed to facilitate the recording of all information about pupils on the school's Special Educational Needs Register including their needs, Individual Education Plans (IEPs) and details of their reviews, etc. The program can be used either individually on a PC or laptop or on a network. The latter option would give all teachers in a large school access to information on pupils with special educational needs with the Senco controlling the modification of information about the pupils.

It is intended to aid the smooth programming and running of assessments of pupils and the monitoring of their progress, and this use in particular will be a focus of my evaluation. Of particular value should be the timed to-do lists which should alert the Senco to the need for updates of IEPs or dates for reviews. It is also designed to enable the Senco to keep well-structured notes leading to well-focused reports. The Senco is free to choose how groups within the system are structured and I intend to look at different options for this e.g. year groupings or pupils grouped according to the different stages within the Code of Practice. It also has an option which would enable the monitoring of pupils who are of concern to teachers but for whom it is not felt necessary to place them on the Special Needs Register.

I hope to investigate both the use of it on my own portable system and also on the school's network and seek the opinion of colleagues, both form and subject teachers, on its effectiveness in meeting their needs.
